



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We encourage children to talk about their experiences. This will enable children to grow in confidence and help them reinforce new vocabulary. Sharing their weekend news raises self esteem and confidence.

Physical Development

We will help children to develop their fine and gross movements through jigsaws, cutting, writing and threading. We will raise awareness of a range of healthy practices with regard to eating, exercise and hygiene.

Understanding of the World

We will be investigating our local environment by identifying mini beasts and learning about how to take care of our environment.

Literacy -Reading and Writing
