
Birmingham Covid-19 Early Help for children & families in ten localities



New early help support has been set up in ten localities to respond to Covid-19.

In each locality there is a voluntary sector lead and a public sector lead (from the Children's Trust, Council, Forward Steps or Police). These leads are there to build relationships and connect services and the community, for example Schools, Nurseries, GPs, Voluntary, Community and Faith groups.

Our early help approach is rapidly evolving to meet children and families' needs during this difficult time. In each locality we can offer the following:

- 1. Coordinating support to families, including weekly partnership meetings
- 2. Providing advice and guidance to local partners
- 3. Collating a list of families we are worried about
- 4. Mapping local support and resources that families can draw on
- 5. Community grants that voluntary, community and faith groups can apply for
- 6. Resilience funding for families, helping with money, food, medicines, white goods, etc.
