A trigraph is three letters that make one sound such as ear, ure, air. Challenge: Can you write a sentence using one of the words you have learnt from the video? What digraph/trigraph are you going to use. Click on the link below to access the game. Today you are going to have a go at describing what different minibeasts look like. Choose 4 minibeasts and have a go at writing a sentence using describing words. Encourage children to think about what the minibeast looks like. Go through the different describing words with your child before encouraging them to think of a sentence. Things to remember when writing: Remember your capital letter at the start of the sentence. Make sure children are writing on the line. Remember to use finger spaces between each word.
