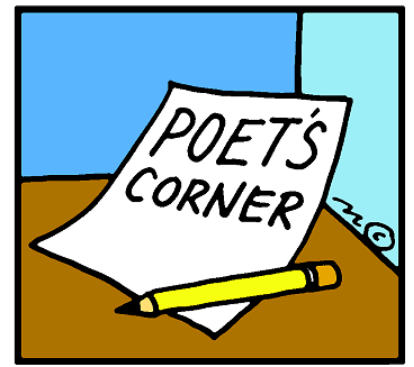


Friday reading challenge

Top Tips

2. Create a word bank of words associated with that subject e.g sky, clouds, passengers, holidays, people, pilots, birds, travels etc
3. Know use these words to start drafting your funny poem e.g
4. Aeroplanes whooshing through the night sky

Was that noise a plane or thunder?
5. When putting your poem together try and includes some of the following features:
Rhyming
Alliteration
personification
Metaphors
Similes
