**L.K: Using further personification**

Personification is a literary skill that is used to give non-human animals and items human characteristics. A characteristic is a behaviour, feeling etc. that something has. A characteristic of a clown, for example, would be that they are happy. Personification can be used to give an animal human characteristics. The sentence below shows an example:

*The dog **hurried** quickly to get home from his walk as it had just started raining heavily”.*

“**Hurrying**” is a human characteristics and, by giving the dog this characteristic, we are personifying it. We can use personification even more successfully with non-living things.

*The lightning **danced** across the rain-laden sky”.*

As lightning is not human (and doesn't have legs...) it cannot possibly “**dance**”! But, the way in which it moves across the sky can be described as dancing, so we can personify that movement.

Practice this skill with the items and animals below- can you write them into a sentence using personification?

2. Chair
3. Fridge
4. Fly
5. Apple
