However, it isn't too hard to find the names of these if you were to put their description into google. "black and white bird" for example would come up with pictures of a magpie.

I have put an example tally chart for you to use below, but you can also draw this on paper if you want to. I look forward to seeing your excellent work! Hopefully, you will see just how much nature is all around us during our daily lives.

(REMEMBER: A tally chart is made using lines that represent "1". You can group five together (which is worth 5) before you have to start a new group.)
