L.K: To edit, improve and complete your final copy of your book review

Today you will be editing and improving your work firstly. This will involve reading work, checking for errors and thinking about how can make it better. Can you add a fronted adverbial? Can you use a semi-colon or a pair of brackets (to add extra information)? Could you use a more complex word, instead of “nice” how about “fantastic”?

Now, once you have completed your editing and improving, you can form your work into paragraphs and use subheadings to show what you will be talking about in each section. You will also need a catchy and engaging title for your work. You are more than welcome to leave spaces for pictures in your work!

After you have finished, check the bullet-points below again and make sure you have answered each of the questions to the best of your ability:

- What is the book called?
- What characters are there?
- What genre is it? Fiction? Fantasy? Science fiction? Non-fiction?
- What are the positive points about this book?
- What are the negative points about this book? Can it be improved? If you really like the book, maybe you want it to be longer?
- What audience would your book be suited to? Under 5? 5-8? 10-14? 15+? Why?
- How could your book be made suitable for all age groups?
- Would you recommend this book to anybody else?
