L.K: To plan a book review

As we have been off school for a long time (over two months!!), I am hoping that you have read many books and have carried on learning from reading as we would do at school. Therefore, today you are going to choose a book that you have read whilst we have been off school and review it. This means that you are going to have to look at the following:

- What is the book called?
- What characters are there?
- What genre is it? Fiction? Fantasy? Science fiction? Non-fiction?
- What are the positive points about this book?
- What are the negative points about this book? Can it be improved? If you really like the book, maybe you want it to be longer?
- What audience would your book be suited to? Under 5? 5-8? 10-14? 15+? Why?
- How could your book be made suitable for all age groups?
- Would you recommend this book to anybody else?

You will need <u>at least</u> four sentences for each bullet point so that you can give a fair and balanced review of the book. You can write more if you want to though! Once you have finished, you need to check your work for errors in spelling, punctuation and grammar and see if you can add even more complex SPAG (such as fronted adverbials, speech marks etc.)

Tomorrow, you will be checking your work over again, editing and improving and then completing your final copy of your book review.
