L.K: To create our own poems using rhyming couplets

Rhyming couplets are a method of poem writing that involves the last word in a group of two sentences rhyming with each other. For example:

My favourite pet is a rat.

His name is Carl and he's ever so fat.

He broke out one day.

I thought he'd always stay.

Then I found him, eating cake.

With my other rat, Jake.

As you can see, the last word in each sentence pair rhyme with each other. This is a crucial part of writing rhyming couplets and you must do this to complete the task properly!
