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LK: To represent regrouping

Section A is suitable for blue and green table

Section B is suitable for yellow, orange and red table

Today we will revisit regrouping. To regroup means to rearrange groups in place value. Whenever a group of 10 is made, regrouping must take place. Below is a demonstration of the calculation $99+1$. We cannot add another 1 to the ones column so the numbers need regrouping.
