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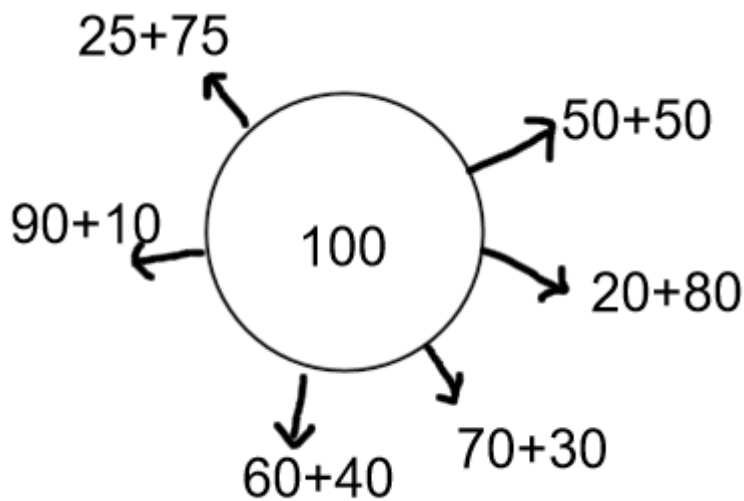
LK: To revise number bonds

Number bonds are two numbers which add together to make a number.

For example, 8 and 2 are number bonds of 10.

Below is an example of how you will set out today's work, drawing it out on pen and paper.

The image below represents number bonds to 100



Set your work out like this

Tip: If you struggle to find number bonds, you can use subtraction to help you. If I wanted to find a number bond of 100, I could subtract a number to identify an answer.  $100-80=20$ . This means that 80 and 20 are number bonds to 100.

Section A- Find at least 4 number bonds for these numbers:

50, 500, 1000 and 10,000

Section B- Find at least 7 number bonds for these numbers:

50, 100, 125, 10,000, 100,000, 1000,000. Extra challenge: find 5 number bonds for the number one
